How soon will we see 3D without putting on those wonky paper glasses? 3D TV was first demonstrated by John Logie Baird initially in 1928 and then again in 1941 using an ingenious system which gave a 600 line full colour 3D image without having to use special glasses. Sadly wartime restrictions meant that the system was not taken up and we have had to wait nearly 70 years for 3D TV to become a serious proposition.

No matter what aspect of TV you work in, this event is essential to take your understanding of 3D to the next dimension.
