

## Keeping you safe at the RTS Student Masterclasses 2021

The RTS would like to reassure those considering attending the Student Masterclasses that we will be taking all necessary measures to ensure your safety.

Our priority is to keep all of us, our families, and colleagues safe. The venue has a thorough hygiene programme in place with regular cleaning of all high-touch surfaces and staff will be using suitable PPE during service. There will be adequate ventilation of spaces and monitoring of the level of CO2 within the venue.

Please be mindful of other visitors and staff and continue to Social Distance within the venue where possible. Guests will be encouraged to handwash and/or hand sanitise upon their arrival. Hands-free sanitising stations will be available in the lobby and by the lifts/entrance of Kelvin Lecture Theatre. We advise guests to wear a face covering whilst moving around the venue.

We are asking that anyone attending takes a lateral flow test on the day of the event. If your test is positive, then please do not attend the event and ensure you follow all necessary government guidance.

We would ask guests to reconsider their attendance, should they or anyone they live with feel unwell in any way, or take a PCR test.
