

Keeping you Safe at RTS Cambridge 2021

Although the Government has eased Covid restrictions, the Society is conscious that some Convention guests will still understandably have concerns about Covid-19. The RTS would like to reassure those attending that we will be taking all necessary measures to ensure your safety while in Cambridge and would appreciate if you would take a few moments to consider the below.

Our priority is to keep all of us, our families, and colleagues safe. We will have a thorough programme to keep high-touch surfaces clean, our RTS staff will be undertaking regular flow testing and we will be passing this safety guidance to all attendees. We do suggest anyone attending also considers organising regular flow tests for their own protection.
