

Keeping you Safe at The RTS NW Awards

Although the Government has eased Covid restrictions, the Society is conscious that some people will still understandably have concerns about Covid-19.

The RTS would like to reassure those attending that we will be taking all necessary measures to ensure your safety whilst at the event and would appreciate if you would take a few moments to consider the below.

Our priority is to keep all of us, our families, and colleagues safe. We will have a thorough programme to keep high-touch surfaces clean, our staff will be undertaking regular flow testing and we will be passing this safety guidance to all attendees. We suggest that anyone attending also considers:

- Taking a lateral flow test or PCR Test in the 48hrs before the event
